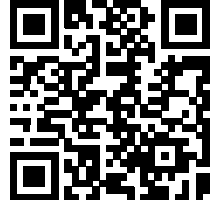


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The Gunpowder Plot



The Gunpowder _____ of 1605 is a famous event in British history. A group of Catholic conspirators, including Guy _____, planned to blow up the House of Lords during the state opening of Parliament. Their goal was to kill King _____ and restore a Catholic monarch to the throne. The _____ rented a cellar under the House of Lords, where they stored 36 barrels of _____.
